Notice of Intent to Award Contract



The purpose of the Hawaii UTelehealth project is to increase health care access and providers' and patients' adoption of telehealth, with emphasis on COVID-related care, including, but not limited to, patients involved with mental and behavioral health issues.

Daniel Cho MD Inc is a S Corporation, in which Dr. Daniel Cho owns 100% of the company. Dr. Cho is a 0.6 FTE employee at the University of Hawai'i Department of Psychiatry. Dr. Cho is not in a supervisory capacity, as a point of contact, or in any role where he would be preparing a fee proposal, contract, invoice or related professional services with his UH position. The UH Department Chair has approved his involvement in Hawaii UTelehealth on his non-UH time.


