- [HB 1916 HD1 SD1 CD1](#). Prohibits, upon written request, making certain information public about certain public servants. Act 187 (7/3/2024).
- [HB 2374 HD1 SD2 CD2](#). Makes emergency appropriations for public employment cost adjustments for, among other entities, the Commission. Act 49 (6/19/2024).
- [SB 2216 SD1 HD1 CD1](#). Clarifies and modernizes how the State Ethics Commission provides advice and conducts investigations (Ethics Commission Package). Act 188 (7/3/2024).
- [SB 2217 HD1 CD1](#). Establishes a phased process for adjusting the reporting period for gift disclosures filed with the State Ethics Commission to conform with the fiscal year. Provides for electronic filing of documents required by the State Ethics Commission (Ethics Commission Package). Act 189 (7/3/2024).
- [SB 3191 SD1 HD2 CD1](#). Eliminates sunset provision of the technology transfer exemption. Act 115 (6/27/2024).
