## CANDIDATE FINANCIAL DISCLOSURES E-FILING INSTRUCTIONS & TIPS FOR FILERS

1. Go to <https://hawaiiethics.force.com/disclosures/s/>.

We recommend Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, or Safari. Do not use Internet Explorer.

2. **Log in to your existing account, or create a new account.**

- a. **Already have an account?** Click **LOGIN** and enter your email and password.

If you already have an e-filing account and file annual financial disclosures as a state employee or member of a state board or commission, log in to your existing account. **Do not create a separate account for your candidate disclosures.**

- b. **New User?** Click **LOGIN** and **SIGN UP** to create a new account (and then check your email to complete your account set up).

3. Once you are logged in, click **MY CANDIDATE DISCLOSURES** on the menu bar.

4. Click on **NEW** button.

If you filed a candidate disclosure during the last election, do not click on the link for previous filing. **You need to create a new form for current election year.** If you click on your previous disclosure, this will only amend your previous filing.

5. **Complete each section.** Candidates are required to report their own financial interests (including jointly held assets), but they are not required to report financial interests that are owned solely by a spouse or dependent child.

**6. To file your form:**

Click **FILE DISCLOSURE** (top of page). A pop-up window will appear on your screen.

Type your name in the Electronic Signature field and click **SAVE** to file your form.
